Overview: Students will work with the given treatment to write a story that serves as the tent pole for Transmedia Indiana. The book will be graded along a continuum, with each draft counting for 10% of the overall grade and the final book counting for 50% of the grade.

Components:

- **Draft:** Students will be asked to write a draft of the story using the treatment, and the pre-report documents. These will be haphazard at first as they will have multiple authors, and shaped as we progress through the semester. The characters and plot within these drafts must be communicated to the larger group so that ancillary and digital assets can be made.
- **Final:** The final story must be written, edited, and delivered in publishable form as it will serve at Part 1 of the Transmedia Indiana narrative book.
